AMERICAN LEGION AUXILIARY EMBLEM

Unity and loyalty are represented by the unbroken circles in blue and gold.

On a blue circle in letters of gold stands the name of the organization... American Legion Auxiliary, a proud name made significant by service to God and Country in war and in peace. The words emphasize Americanism and service.

The field of white exemplifies the hope of freedom.

The Star of Blue is the Emblem of service in war; it is no less the Emblem of service in the time of peace.

Set against a gold background, symbolic of rays of the sun and standing for the principles of Justice, Freedom, Democracy and Loyalty, dispelling the darkness of violence, strife and evil.

When the American Legion Auxiliary was formed to support the work of The American Legion, one of its first acts was to adopt an emblem similar to that of the Legion, yet distinctive and true to the work of the Auxiliary. Under this emblem, the Auxiliary has worked for more than nine decades with the Legion in constructive service to country, America's veterans, active-duty servicemembers and their families.
